



Left, right, left: Contradictions expose ideological confusion

et us start with a joke in a classic format – a Carnatic musician, a mobile app food delivery boy and a social media-savvy godman walk into a bar... And hell erupts.

The Carnatic musician in the middle of a stormy controversy, almost his permanent address, is T. M. Krishna: a Brahmin by birth, winner of the Magsaysay award, perpetual rebel, both an icon and an iconoclast, he combines a peerless artistic genius as a Carnatic vocalist, and is an incessantly mutinous voice, at war with the elitist, Brahmanical, Madras Carnatic music establishment.

The Music Academy chose to bestow on him the title of 'Sangita Kalanidhi', which brought out the prospect of him finally performing at the famous annual conference, which he has boycotted for years. Immediately, several musicians, led by Ranjani and Gayatri, and the Trichur Brothers, who acknowledge his art but scoff his politics, and disagree with his stances against the establishment of Carnatic devotional music, its rigid commitment to puritan discipline, wrote to the Academy expressing their inability to perform at this conference anymore.

This is where the public debate went all wrong. Some of the underlying themes are centuries old should you love the art and ignore the artist? Should the moral conduct of an artist colour our critique of the art? What do you do with an artist whose art you love but disagree with the politics of?

The answer, and an extraordinary insight, was nakedly staring the nation in its face but we ignored it - it missed us in the midst of

an anxiety with alacrity to publicly declare our own stance, to side with one and attack another.

It was the stance taken by the Academy – whose politics Krishna derided and fought, which decided to honour him. The Academy is surely unlikely to be in agreement with Krishna's views on Periyar Ramaswamy, or M.S. Subbalakshmi has chosen to honour his art. This is the biggest insight for us all – honour thy critic.

These days, no one, honours their critic. It is against the spirit of our age, an anathema to our zeitgeist. The badges of honour for critics in our time are trolling, abuse, cancellation, attacks, arrests, cases, and organised hatred. We as a nation missed the extraordinary gesture of the Academy of not only engaging but offering to honour a critic, a bitter, strong critic of the institution.

The debate, paradoxically, had the Left liberal supporters of Krishna flay the cancellation — notwithstanding the glorious history of the Leftists as the fountainhead of the cancellation culture. The right wingers, who sensed a larger BJP-DMK political faceoff in these ideological sparring, turned 'award wapasi' gang and the cancellation supporters. No one was bothered by the contradiction in methods. Oh, how quickly the tables turn.

Around the same time, in the mobile app-based food delivery world, Zomato was cooking up a storm — 'pure' vegetarian food delivery as a service. It raised a far bigger furore, what with apparently more people tending to eat food than listening to carnatic music factoid and all. Champions of pronouns launched a war on the adjective. Staunch advocates

of He/Him and She/Her could not stand pure being attached to vegetarianism.

Like musician Krishna, the war against Zomato's idea was to attack Brahmanism. Again, paradoxically, those who would normally rush to defend the 'food freedom' of people, choose to pan the right of people to eat anything they want — including 'pure' vegetarian food from restaurants of their choice. After all, anyone could opt for the service — universally.

The public debate again quickly became bitter, political, and almost instantly, mindless too. One way in which we can all analyse our honesty in public discourse, to eliminate contradictions and hypocrisy, is to initiate an 'alternate fact check'. Would you condemn an incident, a trend, even if the identity of the players gets changed? Do you condemn a lynching? A violent crime? A public shooting? A rape? Or do you take a stance after verifying the identity of the victim and perpetrator? Do you launch a tirade or go silent based on the identity of a criminal? Does it sound like a lesser crime to you if the perpetrator shares your identity, or political world view?

For example, would you object to someone seeking to order kosher or halal meat-based food orders?, and not wishing to order to eat from any other kind of restaurant? Truth is neither the intrinsic value of any creation getting reduced, nor the gruesomeness of crime augment based on either identity or political worldview of its creator, or perpetrator. But your contradictions reduce you to a hypocritical, opportunist, mean, weak scumbag of a citizen when you change your judgment based on if the author votes like you, or a criminal worships just like you, or not.

In the last fortnight, we witnessed a third incident, which too shared its undercurrents, with the above two — a similar mesh of overlapping tensions was unleashed — discussions unleashed were marked by similar outbursts of collective schadenfreude, or collective rationalising.

Sadhguru Jaggi Vasudev went to hospital for surgery for an emergency treatment, provoking people to call him out for hypocrisy, arguing that since he had advocated ayurveda or naturopathy for people, he should not have gone for an 'allopathic' surgery. Interestingly, those who supported the godman on social media argued that there were no contradictions here, that it was never either-or; there was always a case for allopathic medicine plus alternate medicine where applicable, whereas his critics, almost invariably those who disagree with his ideology, argued that he had "lost his right" to go for treatment.

All three incidents put together beget larger questions for us as a nation. Do we believe in rights for all at all, or just rights for those who support our point of view? Like a licence. Do we believe in any absolute right or wrong, or do we merely conveniently shift all views based on dramatis personae involved in the case?

If the answer is that most of us can justify the wrong done by our party, our leader, our brethren in caste or religion, by someone who we like or agree with, then we have lost all judgment. Because in any public debate, it is seldom about the issue; and almost always about you... and you, and I, are as Indians today, hypocrites.

1. BITSAT

The BITSAT is conducted annually by the Birla Institute of Technology and Science (BITS) Pilani. The exam is conducted in an online computer-based mode for 3 hours. The entire paper, consisting of 390 marks, tests candidates on their knowledge of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, English Proficiency, and Logical Reasoning. Registration for session 2 of BITSAT will begin on May 22 and extend until June 10, and the exam is scheduled to take place from June 22 to 26, 2024.

Qualifying for the exam, candidates can get admission to any of the three BITS campuses in Pilani, Goa, and Hyderabad. To be eligible to answer the exam, candidates need to pass the 10+2 or equivalent exam in Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics with a minimum aggregate of 75 percent marks in the three subjects while scoring a minimum of 60 percent in each subject.

2. COMEDK UGET

COMEDK UGET is among the top 10 engineering entrance exams other than JEE. It is a highly competitive exam that provides admission to undergraduate courses in affiliated private colleges in CBT (Computer-based test) mode.

The paper consists of MCQs (Multiple Choice Questions) which are divided into 3 sections: Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics. The entire exam spans over 3 hours and a total of 180 questions are asked. Registration for the exam is open till April 5, 2024, and the exam is slotted to take place on May 12, 2024.

3. VITEEE

The VITEEE is considered one of the most prestigious engineering entrance exams other than JEE. The exam conducted by Vellore Institute of Technology (VIT) tests the candidates in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, English and Aptitude. VITEEE is an online mode exam where 125 objective questions are asked for 2 hours and 30 minutes. The syllabus is based on the Class 11 and 12 NCERT curriculum. Candidates aspiring to appear for the exam should score a minimum aggregate of 60 percent in Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics in the 10+2 or equivalent exam. The last day to apply for the exam is March 31, 2024, and the

exam will take place between

April 19 to 30, 2024.

4. SRMJEE

5. BSc Courses

In addition to applying for BTech courses, students can also opt for a Bachelor of Science (BSc) in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. The courses are designed to develop a foundational understanding of scientific principles, theories and methodologies among the students. Interested students can appear for CUET UG which is a gateway for admission to prestigious colleges at Delhi University, Banaras Hindu University, Jawaharlal Nehru University, and Jamia Milia Islamia.

Ling said he felt "safe" while strolling around the streets here, unlike the US.

"When we went out, I felt very safe. It was not like we were nervous. San Francisco is a great city but there's a lot of crime that happens there.

"I don't dare to drive my car even eight miles (approximately 13 km) because when I park my car and come back, my window will be broken. The crime rate is so high," he added.

NEW DELHI, Mar 26 (Agencies): Reacting to Jairam Ramesh's remark that Atal Pension Yojana is a "poorly designed scheme", Union Finance Minister Niramala Sitharaman today slammed the Congress general secretary and said that the Congress prefers that the poor should not have pensions so that they are forced to rely on government handouts, which keeps them dependent on "dynasty politicians".

The Congress today attacked the Modi government over the Atal Pension Yojana, alleging it is a "very poorly-designed scheme" and a "paper tiger" that needs officials to hoodwink and coerce people into participating in it.

Lashing out at Congress' criticism of the Atal Pension Yojana, Ms Sitharaman said, "On the Atal Pension Yojana, Jairam Ramesh known for using verbal sophistry to hide facts, is being malicious or is ignorant of the basic tenets of designing a good pension scheme.'

She further said that the Atal Pension Yojana is designed based on best practice choice architecture to automatically continue the premium payment unless the subscriber opts out.

"This is a deliberate and beneficial feature which is in the best interest of the subscribers. Instead of requiring people to decide each year to continue, they have to take a decision to discontinue. This makes many of them take the right decision and save for their retirement," she posted on X.

Speaking at an informal interaction organised by the Thinkers Forum here, Sitharaman said, "The Atal Pension Yojana has benefited 5.26 lakh poor people aged 60 and above in Bengaluru, alone. As many as 1.95 lakh houses have been sanctioned for urban and rural pockets within Bengaluru, and a total of 1.95 lakh houses have been sanctioned under the PM Awas Yojana. Under the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, 11 crore or more wholesale toilets have been constructed all over India and 28,075 household toilets have been constructed in Bengaluru."

The Atal Pension Yojana is the government's flagship social security programme launched eight years ago.

BRS Leader K Kavitha Sent To Jail For 14 Days In Delhi **Liquor Policy Case**



NEW DELHI, Mar 26 (Agencies): A Delhi court on Tuesday sent Bharat Rashtra Samithi leader K Kavitha to jail till April 9.

Ms Kavitha - arrested by the Enforcement Directorate on March 15 in the alleged liquor policy scam that has roiled the city's ruling Aam Aadmi Party - was earlier in the agency's custody; that was extended once last week so she could be confronted with data extracted from her mobile phone. However, in a surprise move today. the ED sought only 15-day judicial custody, meaning Ms Kavitha will now likely be transferred to Delhi's Tihar Jail rather than be held at the agency's lock-up.

The fiery BRS leader hit out at her critics as she was taken from Delhi's Rouse Avenue Court.

She said the case against her "is not money laundering but political laundering", and pointed out her accusers had either joined the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party or donated money to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's party (Rs 50 crore via the controversial and now-scrapped electoral bonds).

"It is a fabricated and false case. One accused has joined BJP, second is getting a BJP ticket, and third accused gave 50 crore in electoral bonds. This is political laundering... we will come out clean.'

In the remand request submitted to the court today, the agency said "it is evident Ms K Kavitha is involved in the acts of payment of kickbacks to government functionaries to gain illegal benefits in the excise policy formulation and implementation..." and that the BRS leader is "actually involved in the transfer of proceeds of crime of 100 crore... which was paid to AAP leaders".

The agency also referred to Ms Kavitha's skipping of summons and claimed she "has not given true and complete disclosure and has not cooperated with the investigation".

Ms Kavitha, meanwhile, sought interim bail on grounds of her minor son's school exams. The bail plea to be heard by a lower court, per the Supreme Court's direction - will be on April 1.

The request was countered by the agency, which wanted to be heard before such an order is passed, pointing to stringent provisions governing bail for those charged under the money laundering act.

The ED has accused Ms Kavitha - the daughter of ex-Telangana Chief Minister K Chandrashekar Rao - of being a key member of the 'South Group' that allegedly paid the AAP a bribe of 100 crore in exchange for liquor licenses under the Delhi government's nowscrapped policy.

The ED also believes the AAP used this money to fund its Goa and Punjab election campaigns.

Following her arrest from Hyderabad in dramatic circumstances that involved a verbal spat between her brother, and former Telangana minister, KT Rama Rao and a team of ED officials - Ms Kavitha had also approached the Supreme Court. However, her appeal was swiftly shot down.

A special bench of Justices Sanjiv Khanna, MM Sundresh, and Bela Trivedi said they could not allow individuals to bypass the lower courts simply because they were persons of influence

The court did, however, issue a notice to the centre on her petition challenging the validity of the PMLA, or Prevention of Money Laundering Act, under which she was arrested.

The centre was given six weeks to respond.

Incidentally, the same bench was to hear an identical plea by Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, who was arrested last week in connection with the same case. He withdrew the plea shortly after Ms Kavitha's was rejected, fearing the same outcome. Mr Kejriwal is now in ED custody till Thursday.

Video footage of the aftermath of the accident shows several two-wheelers hit and lying on the ground, vegetable carts and other stalls crushed and the three men who were in the Scorpio carrying wounds on their bodies from the assault by the locals

The injured were promptly rushed to Bassi Hospital for treatment, however, 70-year-old Mitthu Lal Mewada died during transit to a hospital in Udaipur.

The other injured individual, identified as 75-year-old Kajodimal, was treated at a local hospital before being discharged.

The occupants of the Scorpio were identified as 21-year-old Hardik, 21-year-old Karni Singh, and Tushar Kumar, whose age is being ascertained.

According to the police, the three men, after celebrating the dhulandi festival, a traditional Holi tradition in parts of Rajasthan, had been traversing the streets of Chittorgarh while drunk before calamity hit.

Mitthu Lal Mewada's body was kept in the mortuary of Chittorgarh District Hospital and an autopsy was conducted before it was handed over to his family, police said today.

50 rescued after fire erupts at corporate park in Mumbai; no injuries: Officials



MUMBAI, Mar 26 (Agencies): Nearly 50 people were rescued after a fire erupted in a six-storey corporate park at suburban Mulund in Mumbai on Tuesday morning, officials said.

Those rescued had been stranded on various floors of the smoke-filled building, where the fire started around 9.25 am, a civic official said.

They were moved to safety through a

staircase and with the help of turn-table ladders. There are no reports of any injury to anyone so far, the official said. Another civic official said the fire is confined to the sixth floor of the building 'Avior Corporate Park' on LBS Road.

Hamas rejects latest cease-fire proposal, says Israel ignoring its key demands

JERUSALEM, Mar 26 (Agencies): Hamas has rejected the latest ceasefire proposal, accusing Israel of ignoring its core demands, which include an end to the war and a full withdrawal from Gaza.

In a statement late Monday, the militant group said it had informed mediators that it was sticking to its original position, conveyed earlier in March. It said Israel had not responded to its core demands of a "comprehensive cease-fire, an (Israeli) withdrawal from the Strip, the return of displaced people and a real prisoner exchange."

The statement came shortly after the United Nations Security Council approved a resolution calling for an immediate cease-fire and the release of all hostages held in Gaza.

The vote provoked a clash between Israel and the United States, which decided not to use its veto power Monday. In response, Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu cancelled a high-level delegation's planned visit to Washington.

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has rejected Hamas' demands, calling them "delusional." He has vowed to resume Israel's offensive after any hostage release and keep fighting until Hamas is destroyed.

Hamas is still believed to be holding some 100 hostages, as well as the remains of around 30 others. More than 100 hostages were freed during a weeklong cease-fire in November in exchange for the release of 240 Palestinian prisoners.

An independent expert working with the UN's top human rights body said Monday that there are "reasonable grounds" to believe Israel is carrying out genocide in Gaza. International aid officials say the entire population of the Gaza Strip — 2.3 million people — is suffering from food insecurity and that famine is imminent in the hard-hit north.

More than 32,000 people have been killed in the besieged territory and more than 74,000 wounded, according to Gaza's Health Ministry, which doesn't differentiate between civilians and combatants in its tally. It says women and children make up two-thirds of the dead. Some 1,200 people were killed on October 7 when militants launched a surprise attack out of Gaza, triggering the war, and abducted another 250 people. Hamas is still believed to be holding some 100 Israelis hostage, as well as the remains of 30 others.

Taiwan conducts missile drills in face of Chinese military intrusions

YILAN, Mar 26 (Agencies): Taiwan conducted an air defence test on Tuesday deploying USmade Patriot missiles and its anti-aircraft artillery systems, saying it will ramp up training in the face of Chinese military "intrusions" around the self-ruled island.

Beijing claims Taiwan as part of its territory and has said it will not rule out using force to bring the island under its control.

Chinese warplanes and ships maintain a near-daily presence around the island, as Beijing has ramped up military pressure against Taipei using what experts say are "grey zone" actionstactics that stop short of outright acts of war.

Taiwan's Air Force Command said it conducted an exercise between 5:00 and 7:00 am (2100–2300 GMT Monday) that included the island's domestically made Sky Bow and US-made Patriot surface-to-air missiles, along with army and navy units. "The aim was to verify the command and control of joint air defence operations among the three branches of the military," it said, adding that the exercise went smoothly.

Japan approves plan to sell fighter jets to other nations in latest break from pacifist principles

TOKYO, Mar 26 (Agencies): Japan's Cabinet on Tuesday approved a plan to sell future next-generation fighter jets that it's developing with Britain and Italy to other countries, in the latest move away from the country's postwar pacifist principles.

The contentious decision to allow international arms sales is expected to help secure Japan's role in the joint fighter jet project and part of a move to build up the Japanese arms industry and bolster its role in global security.

The Cabinet also endorsed a revision to Japan's arms equipment and technology transfer guidelines to allow coproduced lethal weapons to be sold to countries other than the partners.

Chief Cabinet Secretary Yoshimasa Hayashi said the changes are necessary given Japan's security environment, but stressed that Japan's pacifist principles remain unchanged.

"In order to achieve a fighter aircraft that meets the necessary performance and to avoid jeopardizing the defense of Japan, it is necessary to transfer finished products from Japan to countries other than partner countries," Hayashi told reporters, adding that Tokyo will follow a strict approval process for jet sales. "We have clearly demonstrated that we will continue to adhere to our basic philosophy as a peaceful nation," he said. Japan has long restricted arms exports under the country's pacifist constitution, but has rapidly taken steps to deregulate amid rising regional



and global tensions, especially from nearby China

The decision on jets will allow Japan to export lethal weapons it coproduces to other countries for the first time.

Japan is working with Italy and the U.K. to develop an advanced fighter jet to replace its aging fleet of Americandesigned F-2 fighters, and the Eurofighter Typhoons used by the U.K. and Italian militaries.

Japan, which was previously working on a homegrown design to be called the F-X, agreed in December 2022 to merge its effort with a British-Italian program called the Tempest. for deployment in 2035. The joint project, known as the Global Combat Air Program or GCAP. is based in the U.K. Japan hopes the new plane will offer advanced capabilities Japan needs amid growing tensions in the region, giving it a technological edge against regional rivals China and Russia.

The change cleared the way for Japan to sell U.S.-designed Patriot missiles to the United States, helping replace munitions that Washington is sending to Ukraine.

In its decision, the Cabinet said that the arms export ban on finished products would hinder efforts to develop the new jet, and limit Japan to a supporting role in the project. Italy and the U.K. are eager to make sales of the jet in order to defray development and manufacturing costs.

Kishida sought Cabinet approval before signing the GCAP agreement in February, but it was delayed by resistance from his junior coalition partner, the Buddhist-backed Komeito party. The change also comes as Kishida is planning an April state visit to Washington, where he is expected to stress Japan's readiness to take on a greater role in military and defense

HONG KONG, Mar 26 (Agencies): Hong Kong's leader said Tuesday that people convicted on national security charges would no longer be eligible for early release for good behaviour, under a new law enacted by the city's authorities over the weekend.

His comments came after local media reported that democracy activist Ma Chun-man, who was convicted in 2021 for "incitement of secession" and was expected to be released Monday, had been held back.

Hong Kong's massive and at times violent prodemocracy protests in 2019 brought hundreds of thousands to the streets demanding greater autonomy from

Beijing. In response, authorities cracked down on protesters and Beijing imposed a national security law in 2020, which was supplemented by a new homegrown one enacted over the weekend. "It's been made very

clear that if a prisoner is serving a sentence in respect to his conviction of an offence endangering national security, the prisoner is not entitled to remission," leader John Lee said Tuesday about the new law when asked about Ma's case.

Commonly referred to as "Article 23", the law also applies to those sentenced before it was passed, he said. "The ordinance has

due to good behaviour also made it clear that for prisoners convicted

of crimes of either the security law or other offences deemed national security threats by authorities.

Ma, 34 -- nicknamed "Captain America 2.0" for carrying a replica of the Marvel superhero's shield at protest rallies in 2019 -- was convicted of "incitement to secession" in 2021.

He had successfully appealed to reduce his sentence by nine months to five years in 2022 as appeal judges deemed his culpability as "relatively low".

Under the new law, Ma would have to remain behind bars for another 20 months.

Do not challenge the law," Lee said Tuesday. India tour of Australia: Day-night Test returns, Perth to host series opener

NEW DELHI, Mar 26 (Agencies): India will play the first of their much-anticipated 5-Test series in Australia in Perth from November 22 and the series will also feature a day-night Test between the two teams at the Adelaide Oval from December 6. Cricket Australia on Tuesday, March 26 announced the schedule for their home summer in 2024-25 which features the high-octane Border-Gavaskar Trophy series. India will have their task cut out to make it a hat-trick of Test series wins in Australia as they begin the series in their least favourite venue in Perth. The pink-ball Test also returns for the first time since India's tour in 2020-21 and it will be played In Adelaide, the venue where the team collapsed for 36-all out before making a sensational comeback and winning the series. India will play a day-night Test for the first time since March 2022 when they defeated Sri Lanka in Bengaluru. The hosts did not play day-night Tests in

At 24, Gill is the youngest captain in the IPL but he showcased his mettle against MI in the leadership role. However, Gill's task is made tad easier as he has head coach Ashish Nehra, who owns a tactically brilliant mind, the experienced David Miller and New Zealand skipper Kane Williamson by his side.

Gaikwad, on the other hand, impressed on his captaincy debut under the tutelage of the talismanic Dhoni as CSK breezed to a six-wicket win against RCB.

But the bowling unit will eye an improved effort especially pacer Tushar Deshpande. After Mustafizur Rahman sizzled with a four-wicket haul, the CSK bowlers let Anuj Rawat and Dinesh Karthik put up a 95-run stand to let RCB put a decent total on the board.

Deshpande was guilty of leaking runs and he would be wary of another mediocre performance with veteran Shardul Thakur, who is also a handy customer with the bat, and the uncapped Mukesh Choudhary lurking around for a chance in the playing XI.

Sri Lankan pacer Matheesha Pathirana has also been declared fit to play, having recovered from his hamstring injury.

Furthermore, there's a chance that Rachin Ravindra can be used as a spin option, who has been bowling well in the nets of late.

CSK are unlikely to fiddle with their batting line-up.

On the other hand, the Titans will hope for a better outing with the bat, following a mediocre display against MI at home. The GT batters failed to convert their starts and the former champions would

need Gill and veteran wicketkeeper batter Wriddhiman Saha to give them an explosive start.

The middle-order batters comprising the likes of Azmatullah Omarzai, David Miller and Rahul Tewatia will have to pull up their socks as well.

Meanwhile, GT's Chennai-born cricketer Sai Sudarshan, who has been in good form with the bat of late, will draw some attention from the crowd.

In the absence of veteran pacer Mohammad Shami, the Titans bowlers put up a consolidated effort to eke out a six-run win over Mumbai.

Dinesh Karthik becomes second highest run-getter in death overs of IPL since 2022



BENGALURU, Mar 26 (Agencies): Royal Challengers Bengaluru (RCB) batter Dinesh Karthik became the player with the highest strike rate and the second-highest run-getter in the death overs (17-20 overs) following his outstanding cameo against the Punjab Kings (PBKS).

Virat Kohli's batting masterclass combined with Karthik and Mahipal Lomror's finishing touches sealed a four-wicket win for the RCB against PBKS at the M. Chinnaswamy Sta-

The right-hand batter played an unbeaten knock of 28 runs from just 10 balls which was laced with three fours and two sixes in his innings. In this innings the 38-year-old cricketer scored runs at a strike rate of 280. With this knock, the Chennai-born player became the second-highest run-getter in the death overs (17-20 overs). He has scored 372 runs at a strike rate of 203.27 and is just behind Rajasthan Royals (RR) batter Shimron Hetmyer who has scored 383 runs at a strike rate of 197.42.

The other three batters in the top five list are Rinku Singh of Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) with 351 runs at a strike rate of 195, Tim David from Mumbai Indians (MI) who has scored 290 runs at a strike rate of 207.14 and at the fifth number comes left-hand batter David Miller from Gujarat Titans (GT) who has scored 285 runs at a strike rate of 161.01. Coming to the match, Punjab Kings (PBKS)

saw their batters getting starts but none of them could convert them into something

big. Skipper Shikhar Dhawan (45 in 37 balls with five fours and a six), Jitesh Sharma (27 in 20 balls with a four and two sixes) and Sam Curran (23 in 17 balls) played decent knocks, but on a batting-friendly Chinnaswammy pitch, PBKS could muster only 176/6 in 20 overs.

Mohammed Siraj (2/26) and Glenn Maxwell (2/29) took two scalps each. Yash Dayal and Alzarri Joseph took a wicket each.

In the chase of 177, RCB lost wickets at regular intervals, but Virat (77 in 49 balls, with 11 fours and two sixes) held the ship steady at the other end. After his dismissal, things got tricky for RCB, but strong finish from Dinesh Karthik (28* in 10 balls, with three fours and two sixes) and Mahipal Lomror (17* in eight balls, with two fours and a six) guided the team to a four-wicket win with four balls left.

Harpreet Brar (2/13) and Kagiso Rabada (2/23) were the pick of the bowlers for PBKS. Kohli was awarded Player of the Match for his marvellous innings.
